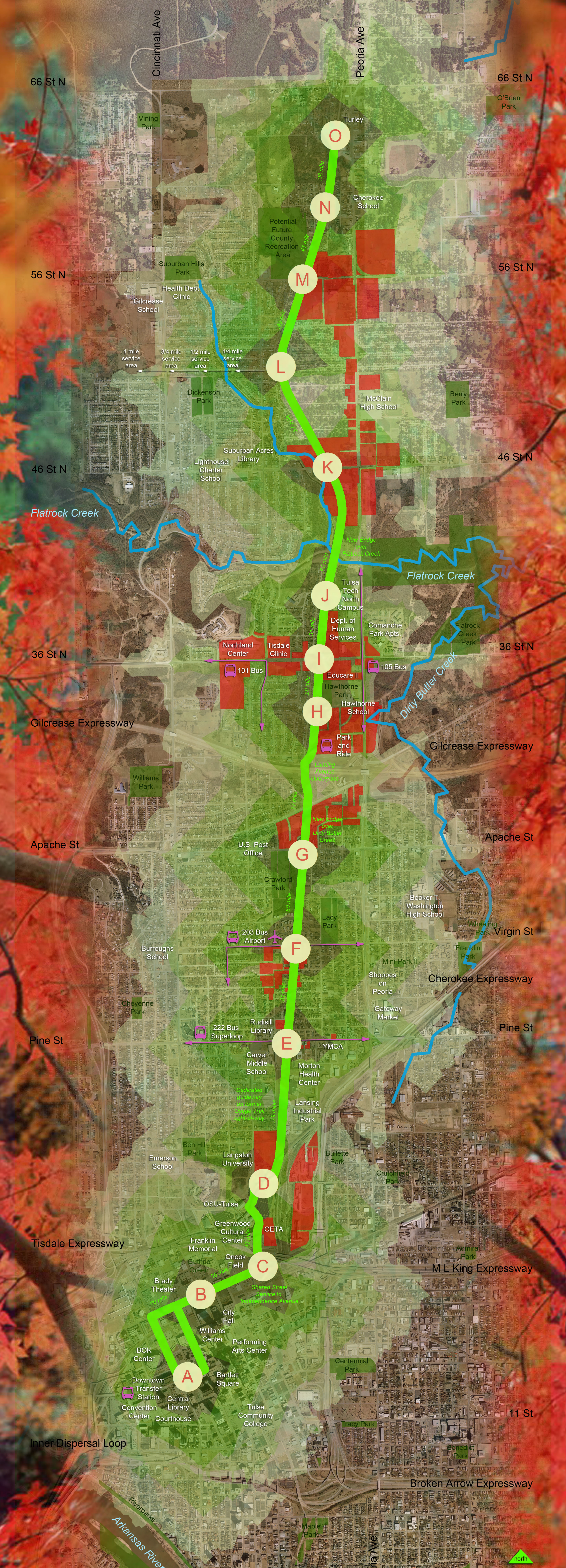

The Greenwood Line or G-Line could be Tulsa's first rapid transit line utilizing a dedicated right-of-way with bus rapid transit or BRT technology. The line runs seven and three quarters miles from Downtown through North Tulsa. Buses running every ten minutes could make the trip one-way in under thirty minutes, express buses at peak times could be even faster. The hybrid vehicles run on city streets with signal priority using CNG from downtown to OSU-Tulsa before switching to a fixed guideway with overhead electric power for the rest of the trip adjacent to the Osage Mixed Use Trail. The G-Line's route was selected to provide service to an area of the city with high transit ridership that was identified as a high priority in the PlantTulsa Comprehensive Plan with over 32,000 residents in more than 15,000 households within 1 mile of the route. The line serves many existing destinations and connects to several existing bus routes including airport service. It is also close to more than 500 acres of property designated by the plan as medium density, mixed-use redevelopment areas in town and regional centers. The G-Line could be a catalyst for the rebirth of this side of the city with its excellent proximity to high wage jobs and an overlooked natural beauty.
