However, if additional services are needed the following providers have been identified as resources. These resources may or may not be covered by health insurance. If services are not covered by health insurance the department may elect to provide assistance for the financial cost.

1. The resident has made insufficient progress toward correcting performance issues identified in a written notification.
2. The resident wishes to pursue specialized assessments, such as comprehensive neuropsychological testing, which may inform the Program Director in order to revise the resident's improvement plan per written notification.
3. The resident may release the results of such specialized assessments to the Program Director.

Examples of specialized assessments include:

1. Comprehensive neuropsychological testing: typically evaluates for underlying psychiatric, learning, cognitive, and other disorders

2. Professional Renewal Center, which offers individualized, comprehensive assessment programs including:
 - Psychiatric evaluation
 - Comprehensive psychological testing, the nature of which is tailored to the diagnostic questions
 - Individual clinical interviews and situational analysis focused on the presenting problems as these relate to administrative, regulatory, and

licensure issues, characteristics of the professional/organizational work setting, and personal psychological history

- Review of collateral information provided by the patient, referring parties, and other appropriate sources
- Thorough medical evaluation
- Careful analysis of social, family, and religious/spiritual history
- Addiction and Sexuality Assessment
- Behavioral observation within our physician-peer assessment/treatment milieu
