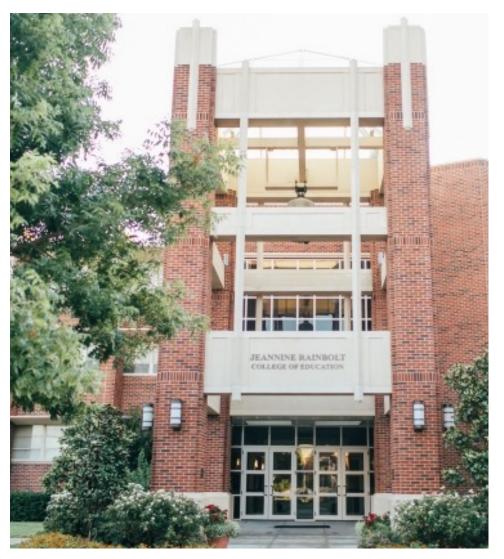

 - Statement of Purpose
 - Letter of Recommendation
 - Writing Sample
- Application priority due dates:
 - Dec 1st
 - Extended deadline: March 1, 2024

- Methods course (15 hours)
 - Quantitative Data Analysis (2 courses, 6 hours)
 - Qualitative Research Methods & Data Analysis (2 courses, 6 hours)
 - Advanced Research Methods (1 course, 3 hours)
- Electives (45-58 hours)
- Prospectus Development (1 course, 3 hours)
- Dissertation Research (2 hours min 15 hours max)
- Total of 90 hours

Course Delivery Modes

Codes	Use	Reference	
BLDW	Blended with in-person and asynchronous online	Blended or Blended Asynchronous	A course that has a significant portion of the contact and instruction by in-person delivery and the remaining portion by asynchronous online delivery
BLDS	Blended with in-person and synchronous online	Blended or Blended Synchronous	A course that has a significant portion of the contact and instruction by in-person delivery and the remaining portion by synchronous remote delivery
SYNC	Synchronous Video Conference	Remote	A course that has all contact and instruction by synchronous remote delivery or a significant portion of the delivery by synchronously remote delivery
TRAD	In-person course with full contact time	Traditional	A course that has all direct instruction in-person
WEB	Asynchronous Online	Online	A course that has direct instruction by predominantly asynchronous online delivery
