- Music Theory 6 hours
Any two graduate-level Music Theory (MUTH) courses with these exceptions: MUTH 5811, MUTH 5821. No coursework taken to remedy deficiencies in Music Theory determined by the student's score on the Preliminary Exam may be applied to this requirement and no Music Technology (MUTK) course may be applied to this requirement.
