Report of New Undergraduate Transfers, 2023-2024

Notes and Definitions

- 1. For the purposes of this report, New Undergraduate Transfers are defined as students who have attempted more than six hours of collegiate work after high school graduation and who have never before enrolled in any University of Oklahoma programs.
- 2. This report includes students enrolling at OU for the first time in either Fall semester (including the immediately preceding Summer who subsequently enrolled in Fall) or Spring semester, unless otherwise indicated. Reports prior to AY24 did not include Spring transfers.
- 3. Last Institution Attended is determined by which institution the student attended most recently, regardless of whether it was the institution where a student earned the majority of their transfer credit.
- 4. Enrollment data are taken from a snapshot of students enrolled as of the Official Reporting Date (ORD) for the Fall or Spring semester (whichever is the student's first semester at OU). ORD is the first working day following three full weeks of classes, at which point the normal add/drop period is over and an official census can reasonably be taken. - 5. Transfer GPA is based on all transfer work, from all prior institutions, loaded into the student information system (SIS).
- 6. Spring OU GPA in this report is calculated as of the end of the transfer student's first Spring semester at OU and includes only OU coursework.

 Transfer GPA includes only transfer coursework.
- 7. For the purposes of this report Adjacent States are defined as: Arkansas, Colorado, Kansas, Louisiana, Missouri, and Texas (unless listed separately).
- 8. Data missing in the source systems are shown as "Unknown" in this report unless otherwise noted.
- 9. In previous reports, Academic Class was based only on transfer hours loaded into Banner. Starting with the AY 2023-2024 report, Academic Class is based on the academic class loaded into Banner. Therefore previous years' report numbers may not match numbers from this report or reports going forward.
- 10. Percentage columns on Headcount of New Undergraduate Transfer Students by Last Institution Attended page are based on all students majoring in that college. Some students have majors in multiple colleges; therefore, percentages may add up to more than 100%.
- 11. To prevent unintended personal data disclosure, GPAs in cells representing data for one person have been redacted (indicated by gray fill).


