## **Enrollment Analysis Report**

## **Notes and Definitions**

- 1. Enrollment data are taken from a snapshot of students enrolled as of the Official Reporting Date (ORD) for that semester. The Official Reporting Date corresponds to the first working day following three full weeks of classes, at which point the normal add/drop period is over and an official census can reasonably be taken.
- 2. Norman Campus enrollment represents an unduplicated count of all students enrolling in courses offered by several different OU campus/program organizational entities, all of which are tied geographically and/or administratively to the Norman Campus. They are:

Norman On-Campus Extended Campus - Liberal Studies Courses

OU-Tulsa - Norman Programs Extended Campus - Academic Programs Courses

Winter Session Extended Campus - North America and Europe Courses

Extended Campus - Center for Independent & Distance Learning Courses

Given the amount of cross-enrollment between these different campus/program areas, an overall Norman Campus enrollment is most appropriate to use for the majority of reporting purposes. Enrollment can be split out by campus/program area if special circumstances call for it; check with IRR if you suspect you might need something other than Norman Campus overall enrollment.

- 3. Students in the Undergraduate level are those pursuing bachelor's degrees. Students in the Graduate level are pursuing master's, graduate certificate, and research doctoral programs, all administered by the Graduate College. Students in the Professional level are in programs preparing for professional practice; currently only the College of Law offers Professional programs.
- 4. It is possible for a student to be in more than one level of degree program during a single semester: master's and graduate certificate; undergraduate and master's (accelerated degree); graduate master's and professional doctorate (for example, MBA/JD); etc. Because of this, unduplicated totals are provided wherever necessary.
- 5. Some students choose to pursue multiple majors within a single degree, or multiple degrees simultaneously, and those multiple disciplinary areas often cross into multiple colleges and/or departments. Because a student is listed in every college/department associated with their major area of study, it is not possible to add up enrollment by college without duplication. Always use the unduplicated total for the level of summary you need, to avoid accidental double-counting of students.
- 6. Enrollment shown for University College includes students in 2-year pre-professional programs (such as pre-nursing studies); these students are taking coursework in preparation for transfer to upper level professional programs not offered at the Norman campus. All other pre-professional students (4-year pre-health, pre-law, etc.) are pursuing a degree program in addition to their pre-professional course work so are reported in the college of their degree-granting major.
- 7. A full-time (FT) course load is defined for undergraduates is at least 12 credit hours; less than that is part-time (PT). A graduate/professional full-time course load is defined as at least nine credit hours, unless the student also has at least a .50 FTE appointment as a graduate assistant. Students with both a graduate assistant appointment and a five-credit hour load are considered full-time. Graduate assistants enrolled in at least two credit hours during their final semester are considered full-time. Because graduate assistant appointments are not finalized for reporting until the HR ORD of November 1, an accurate assignment of FT/PT cannot be made for graduate/professional students until then. Once graduate assistant appointments are verified, the FT/PT status is updated on this report.
