



Accelerated PE/MBA Program

The accelerated BS in Petroleum Engineering/MBA degree program is designed for the petroleum engineering student with an interest in business. The synergy of this track is strengthened by incorporating the Energy specialization of the MBA program into the accelerated curriculum. Students graduating with this option will graduate with sound engineering fundamentals along with business and energy knowledge.

Interested students will apply to the program in their Junior year and must meet the following requirements:

- OU Petroleum Engineering undergraduate student
- Minimum OU Retention GPA and combined retention GPA of 3.0 or above
- Petroleum Engineering Major GPA of 3.0 or above
- Junior standing in the Petroleum Engineering curriculum
- At least 12 credit-hours of Petroleum Engineering courses completed at OU
- GMAT taken during Junior year (prior to April 1)

A *PE/MBA Application* form should be submitted, *along with a personal statement re lecting on career goals and interest in graduate business education*, to the MPGE Coordinator of Student Relations, SEC 1268 by **January 15** of the Junior year.
