Good morning Graduate Student Assistants and Salaried Student Employees!

I hope your summer is going well. I wanted to check in to make sure you are aware that your paycheck will be changing after June 30<sup>th</sup>. **Your June 30<sup>th</sup> paycheck is your LAST MONTHLY PAYCHECK!** You will get your first biweekly paycheck on July 26<sup>th</sup> (this paycheck is less than half of your monthly paycheck). Beginning with your July 26<sup>th</sup> paycheck, you'll start getting paid every other Friday. Please take a look at the [payday calendar](#) and make sure you are familiar with your new pay schedule.

**This payday change may impact your personal finances and bill payments. Don't wait! Become informed and prepared now.**

If you are on leave of absence over the summer, when you return in August you will begin getting paid on a biweekly schedule. If you graduate before July 1, 2024, or will no longer be employed with the University by July 1, then you may disregard this email. See the schedule and calendar below for important dates.

### Payday Schedule for July 2024 Transition – Graduate Assistants & Other Salaried Students

The calendars below correspond to the following bulleted dates:

06/30/24: Last monthly paycheck for June 1-30<sup>th</sup>

07/01/24: First biweekly pay period begin date

07/26/24: First biweekly paycheck for the pay period 07/01/24 - 07/12/24

08/10/24: First biweekly pay period begin date for fall 2024 semester

- If you are on leave of absence over the summer; this will be the beginning of the fall 2024 semester and your first biweekly pay period. You would have received your last monthly paycheck in May likely for half a month if you are a 9-month appointed GA.

09/06/24: First biweekly paycheck for the fall 2024 semester

*Note: If you are being paid to teach courses over the summer your pay schedule may vary. Please check in with your paying department to confirm your pay schedule.*
