APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID

To apply for financial aid you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at studentaid.ed.gov. Make sure you first obtain a U.S. Department of Education PIN number at pin.ed.gov. Your pin number, which serves as your electronic signature, is required to complete your application. The FAFSA website provides help information online and also phone numbers if you wish to contact a representative for assistance. The FAFSA number is 1-800-4-FED-AID. You may contact the Tulsa Financial Aid Office at 918-660-3387 for further assistance. Be sure to check out OU's recommended deadlines and additional financial aid information on One or ou.edu/sfc

COMPLETE ANY OUTSTANDING DEPARTMENTAL REQUIRMENTS

SET UP YOUR OUNET ACCOUNT

Your OUNet Account is your key to accessing OU technology resources, such as email, enrollment, grades, course materials, computer labs and OU libraries resources. Many OU offices will only communicate with you via your official OU email account.

Your OUNetID is the username issued to you upon admission. To locate this you will need to set up your account & password.

ACCESS OU's student PORTAL

One is OU's student portal. It is designed to give OU students personalized access to extensive campus resources in one location. **One** allows you to customize what you see and do in the portal based on your personal preferences and interests. To access the portal, go to <u>one.ou.edu</u>. You will be asked for your username (OUNet ID) and password. Once you have logged in, you can use the navigation tools to personalize your pages.

Setting up your account and choosing a password:

- 1. Go to <u>One.ou.edu</u> and click on "New to OU? Setup your OU account"
- 2. Enter your Date of Birth and the OUNetID or SoonerID you were given in your admission letter
- 3. Create a new password
- 4. Log back on and set emergency contact info and enter password retrieval e-mail
- 5. Make note of this information as that will be your logon from this point forward

*Write down the OUNetID and password in a secure location as you will need it throughout your career at OU and afterwards!

If you forget your password:

If you forget your password, you can reset it online at anytime by following these steps:

- 1. Go to One.ou.edu
- 2. Click on the link that says "Forgot your password?"
- 3. Follow instructions provided

ENROLLMENT

Before enrolling in classes, you may have holds that need to be cleared. Check with your department advisor for assistance. Check OnPoint via the student portal for any required trainings. Once all holds are removed, you can enroll online through the student portal One. To locate contact information for your advisor, please visit your academic college website (to find your college website, visit the Tulsa website)

Enroll or get your schedule:

For enrollment services, schedules, and estimated costs, and classroom locations go to **One**. Course syllabi are found on OU's learning management system Canvas—which can be found through **One**. Course materials are available through our on-line bookstore at https://ou.textbookbrokers.com

Pay Your Bill:

To pay your bill in person (check or cash), visit the **Student Enrollment Center, 1C114**. Mailed payments may go to the SEC or to the **OU Office of the Bursar on the Norman campus**. To pay online, either by credit card or EFT from your bank, which is the FASTEST way to have your payment applied, go to: http://one.ou.edu

Get an OU ID Card:

To get your OU ID card, visit **Student Enrollment Center** in **1C114**. A \$15 charge is payable at time of service.

Request a Transcript:

There is no charge for transcripts. To request one, visit **Student Enrollment Center**, **1C114** or email the request to tulsa.sec@ou.edu
